- 1. Submission of Registration
 - a. Parents/Guardians are required to register their child for the sacrament. This can be done online or in paper form.
 - i. There is a \$30 fee for materials provided during the year.
 - ii. If possible, please attach a copy of the child's Baptism Certificate
- 2. Attendance
 - a. Candidates are required to be present for all scheduled Meetings, Spirit Day, and Group Service Project.
 - i. If a Candidate is unable to be in attendance, make-up activities must be completed. These make-up activities can be found on our website.
 - Make-Up Activities must be completed no later than <u>TWO WEEKS</u> from the date of the originally scheduled meeting.
- 3. Journals
 - a. Journals are to be filled out in their entirety. This includes answering all questions and obtaining a signature from the Confirmation Sponsor at the Sponsor/Candidate dinner.
 - i. Confirmation Journals must be completed by:
 - 1. January 22nd for SMS Students (Turn in to Mrs. Cannell)
 - 2. February 11th for FGF/FT Students (Turn in to FGF Teacher or Parish Office)
- 4. Completion of a Confirmation Interview
 - a. Confirmation Interviews are an important part of preparation to receive the sacrament. During this interview, each Candidate will meet with a member of the Confirmation Team to review their complete journal and discuss faith formation.
- 5. Completion of 10 hours of Service to the Community in which the Candidate is empowered by the Gifts of the Holy Spirit
 - a. A list of examples of acceptable hours will be provided.
 - i. These hours must be completed by May 1st, 2024.
 - b. This does NOT include the hours accumulated at the St. Michael Parish Easter Egg Hunt.
 - Candidates are expected to complete a group service project through the Confirmation Program: helping to facilitate the Parish Easter Egg Hunt on Saturday, March 23rd.
